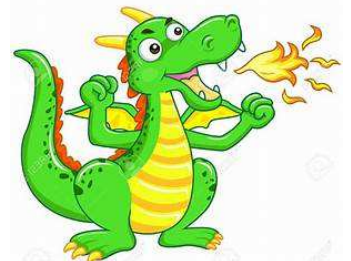
Sports
