1 Introduction

1.1 At St Leonard's Academy we are committed to the protection of all the staff and pupils against excessive exposure to the sun. We will work with staff, pupils and parents/carers and school governors to achieve through the measures listed below.

2 Education

- 2.1 All pupils will receive information on Safe in the Sun as part of their PSHE sessions and also be reminded of it during morning assembly in the summer months
- 2.2 Parents/carers will be sent a letter explaining what the school is doing about sun protection and how they can help at the beginning of the summer term
- 2.3 Teachers will ensure that they are updated on all aspects of sun safety before the summer term each year

3 Shade

- 3.1 We have purchased 2 permanent shade canopies in the playground
- 3.2 During very hot days pupils can stay inside the school building during lunch time

4 Sports Days

- 4.1 Our sports days will start from 9:30am in order to avoid the hottest part of the day

5 Clothing

- 5.1 A legionnaire type hat will be part of our school uniform for the summer months

6 Sunscreen Cream

- 6.1 The use of sunscreen cream will be encouraged on school trips and for use at playtimes in sunny weather

We will monitor our progress and review this policy every two years
